## THE CONCEPT OF GOD IN ISLAM:

The concept of God is unique in Islam. It is not shared by any other religion. Almighty God is one and indivisible. God is unlike any other being in existence. He is uncreated, whereas everything else is His creation. He has no beginning and no end. God was not begotten, nor He begetteth; He has no father, no mother, no son, and no consort. He is sublime and non-physical. He needs no helpers and no associates. He is omnipotent and omnipresent.

He is fully aware of the innermost feelings deep inside the heart of His subjects. He is loving, kind, compassionate, forgiving, relenting, generous and benevolent. God says in the holy scripture, the Qur'an, that when He intends a thing, He says to it 'Be' and it 'Is.' (exists). This is not because of any spoken words, for God has no organs of communication like humans. It is just an intention and it comes into existence.

To know God fully is beyond human intellectual capacity. His essence is beyond human reach. Even if one's flight of imagination fancies what God is, that is not God.
