Dua containing Isme Aa'zam.

Hadith. A man asked Hazrat Ali (A.S), what as the most powerful communication that Allah sent through angel Jibreel to the Prophet (pbuh&p). Please share it with me.

He replied, "If you wish to call Allah with **His Isme Aa'zam**, then recite the first six verses of Surah *Al Hadid* (57: 1-6), then recite the last four verses of Surah Al Hashr (59: 21-24)

سَبَّحَ بِسَّهِ مَا فِي ٱلسَّمَٰوٰتِ وَٱلْأَرْضِ ﴿ وَهُوَ ٱلْعَزِيزُ ٱلْحَكِيمُ

1. Everything in the heavens and the earth Glorifies God . He is the Almighty, the Wise.

٢ لَهُ مُلْكُ ٱلسَّمَٰوٰتِ وَٱلْأَرْضِ ۖ يُحْى ۗ وَيُمِيتُ ۖ وَهُوَ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

2. To Him belongs the kingdom of the heavens and the earth. He gives life and causes death, and He has power over all things.

٣ هُوَ ٱلْأُوَّلُ وَٱلْءَاخِرُ وَٱلظُّهِرُ وَٱلْبَاطِنُ ﴿ وَٱلْبَاطِنُ ۗ وَهُوَ بِكُلِّ شَيْءٍ عَلِيمٌ

3. He is the First and the Last, and the Outer and the Inner, and He has knowledge of all things.

4. It is He who created the heavens and the earth in six days, then settled over the Throne. He knows what penetrates into the earth, and what comes out of it, and what descends from the sky, and what ascends to it. And He is with you wherever you may be. God is Sees everything you do.

لَّهُ مُلْكُ ٱلسَّمَٰوٰتِ وَٱلْأَرْضِ ۚ وَإِلَى ٱللَّهِ تُرْجَعُ ٱلْأُمُورُ

5. To Him belongs the kingship of the heavens and the earth, and to God all matters are referred.

لَولِجُ ٱلنَّيْلَ فِي ٱلنَّهَارِ وَيُولِجُ ٱلنَّهَارَ فِي ٱلنَّيْلِ وَهُوَ عَلِيمٌ بِذَاتِ ٱلصُّدُورِ

6. He merges the night into the day and merges the day into the night; and He has full knowledge of the secrets of the hearts.

٢١ لَوْ أَنزَلْنَا هَٰذَا ٱلْقُرْءَانَ عَلَىٰ جَبَلٍ لَّرَأَيْتَهُ خُشِعًا مُّتَصندِّعًا مِّنْ خَشْيَةِ ٱللَّهِ ۖ وَتِلْكَ ٱلْأَمْثُلُ نَضْربُهَا لِلنَّاسِ لَعَلَّهُمْ يَتَفَكَّرُونَ

21. Had We sent this Quran down on a mountain, you would have seen it trembling, crumbling in awe of God. These parables We cite for the people, so that they may reflect.

22. He is God. There is no god but He, the Knower of things secrets and open. He is the Compassionate, the Merciful.

23. He is God; besides Whom there is no god; the Sovereign, the Holy, the Peace-Giver, the Faith-Giver, the Overseer, the Almighty, the Omnipotent, the Overwhelming. Glory be to God, beyond what they associate.

24. He is God; the Creator, the Maker, the Designer. His are the Most Beautiful Names. Whatever is in the heavens and the earth glorifies Him. He is the Majestic, the Wise.

Then he said: Raise both your hands and say: O Allah, You are such that I call upon you by the rights of *Your Asmaa ul Husna*, that You (Allah) send peace and blessings on Muhammad and his family (Allahumma Salli A'laa Muhammadin wa Aali Muhammad). Then ask for your need. By Allah, besides Him there is no other god, your need will be fulfilled InshaaAllah.
