Allah! There is no deity save Him, the Alive, the Eternal. Neither slumber nor sleep overtakes Him. To Him belongs whatsoever is in the heavens and whatsoever is in the earth. Who is he that intercedes with Him save by His leave? He knows that which is in front of them and that which is behind them, while they encompass nothing of His knowledge save what He will. His throne includes the heavens and the earth, and He is never weary of preserving them. He is the Sublime, the Tremendous. (255)

There is no compulsion in religion. The right direction is henceforth distinct from error. And he who rejectets false deities and believes in Allah has grasped a firm handhold which will never break. Allah is Hearer, Knower. (256).

Allah is the Protecting Guardian of those who believe. He brings them out of darkness into light. As for those who disbelieve, their patrons are false deities. They bring them out of light into darkness. Such are rightful owners of the Fire. They will abide therein. (257)

You cause the night to pass into the day, and You cause the day to pass into the night; You bring forth the living out of the dead, and You bring forth the dead out of living; and You give sustenance to whomever you like without measure.
